URGENT NOTICE

SPECIAL RESOLUTION AND CONCLUSION OF THE PRESCRIBED PRESS RELEASE

That following from our Special Resolution and Conclusion of the press release the following decision has been taken in terms of section 53 (1) and (3) of Insolvency Act NO 24 of 1936 as follows:

1. The press release conclusion constitutes the **INSTITUTE OF FOREIGN GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY COMMITTEE** constituted in terms of the State President's Committee on National Priorities Act NO 119 OF 1984, and the committee shall be constituted of one candidate from all registered political parties having a seat in parliament adopted to be members of the **INSTITUTE OF FOREIGN GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY COMMITTEE**, established by the **Congress of SOUTH AFRICAN COMMUNITY GOVERNMENT UNION-SACGU and Professor of PPE MASTERS Degree (POLITICS PHILOSOPHY AND ECONOMY - PPE)**.
2. The **INSTITUTE OF FOREIGN GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY COMMITTEE** shall have its subcommittees under it one of it called the permanent campaign against all evictions in the Republic of South Africa.
3. The **INSTITUTE OF FOREIGN GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY COMMITTEE** shall have its subcommittee under it, one of it called the permanent repeal of laws committee to amend them and consolidate such laws in terms of the National Legislature and common law of the Constitutional Law of the Statutes of the Republic of South Africa Act 108 of 1996.

4. The first duty of the INSTITUTE OF FOREIGN GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY COMMITTEE by its permanent repeal of laws committee shall deal with the process of the Congress of **SOUTH AFRICAN COMMUNITY GOVERNMENT UNION** articles of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa Act 108 of 1996, which articles repealed the **LONDON CONVENTION** of the 27th of **FEBRUARY 1884** of the *mala fide* political convention by her **MAJESTY THE QUEEN** of the British Government between the Government of the Republic of South Africa of the said convention by her **MAJESTY THE QUEEN** in contravention of section 135 of Insolvency Act N0 24 of 1936 for hijacking the Republic of South Africa before sequestration and annexing the *mala fide* **LONDON CONVENTION** of 27th of February 1884 now repealed in order to repeal and amend the consolidation of the following Acts:

1. **THE SUPREME COURT ACT 59 OF 1959** now by enforced amendment repeal and consolidation by the Congress of South African Community Government Union Article 2001 Government Gazette Registration and patent registration in force.
2. To repeal the **NATIONAL COUNCIL OF PROVINCES established as a substitute of the VOKSTAAT COUNCIL** of the Nation now constituted by Schedule 6 Transitional Arrangements of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa Act 108 of 1996 section (5) (a) this particular section is now repealed subject to sub-section (i) which provides for the repeal of the **NATIONAL COUNCIL OF PROVINCES** the previous **VOLKSTAAT COUNCIL** of the repealed *mala fide* political **LONDON CONVENTION** of 27th February 1884 repealed in terms of the National Legislative Executive Order by the **Congress of SOUTH AFRICAN COMMUNITY GOVERNMENT UNION** in terms of the Special Resolution attached thereto as in terms of section 200 of Companies Act N0 61 of 1973 constituting the **NATIONAL LEGISLATIVE EXECUTIVE ORDER** of the Government of the Republic of South Africa constituting the **INSTITUTE OF FOREIGN GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY COMMITTEE**;
3. To repeal and consolidate the ownership of the Land and Mineral Rights Act;
4. To repeal and consolidate the Internal Security Act;
5. To repeal and consolidate the Companies Act N0 61 of 1973 and to suspend any amendment to it not to be in force on the 1st of June 2010 pending the reinstating of the Department of the Prime Minister.

6. To repeal and consolidate the South African Police Services SAPS Act 1995 as per sequestration order of consent granted to the Congress of South African Community Government Union under the **SOUTH GAUTENG HIGH COURT OF JOHANNESBURG CASE Number 05/20976** of Sequestration Order of consent granted by the **NATIONAL PROSECUTING AUTHORITY and DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC PROSECUTIONS** represented by ADVOCATE **ENDREW MABENA CHAUKE** on behalf of the **STATE** at Court GA on the 24 January 2006 and confirmed on Appeal on the 18th of April 2006 at Court 8E in terms of section 150 of Insolvency Act 24 of 1936 the Sequestered Insolvent Respondents are:
 7. 1. **NATIONAL PROSECUTING AUTHORITY DIRECTOR VUSIMUZI PIKOLI, STATE PROSECUTOR KRIEL STATE PROSECUTOR MADELA AND DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC PROSECUTIONS 1ST INSOLVENT RESPONDENT NOW SEQUESTERED;**
 7. 2. **SOUTH AFRICAN POLICE SERVICES-SAPS 2ND INSOLVENT RESPONDENT NOW SEQUESTERED;**
 7. 3. **MINISTER OF JUSTICE 3RD INSOLVENT RESPONDENT NOW SEQUESTERED;**
 7. 4. **MAGISTRATE VAN VUUREN 4TH INSOLVENT RESPONDENT NOW SEQUESTERED;**
 7. 5. **MINISTER OF FINANCE 6TH INSOLVENT RESPONDENT NOW SEQUESTERED;**
 7. 6. **GOVERNOR OF RESERVE BANK OF SOUTH AFRICA 7TH INSOLVENT RESPONDENT NOW SEQUESTERED;**
8. That the sequestration of these Government Departments constituted sequestration of all Government Departments sequestered in terms of section 128 of Insolvency Act 24 of 1936 stating that Partnership once sequestered cannot be rehabilitated; a partnership whose estate has been sequestered by the Sequestration order of consent in case number 05/20976 shall not be rehabilitated and there shall be no appeal against any Order made by the court in terms of this Act except as provided in this section by section 150

sub-section (5) of Insolvency Act 24 of 1936 confirmed on appeal on the 18th of April 2006.

9. Therefore the **Congress of SOUTH AFRICAN COMMUNITY GOVERNMENT UNION** by its Articles of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa Act 108 of 1996 repealing the political *mala fide* **LONDON CONVENTION** of the 27th **FEBRUARY 1884** which was used to hijack the State and Government of the Republic of South Africa through colonization before sequestration of the Republic of South Africa by Her Majesty the Queen of the British Government in contravention of section 135 of Insolvency Act 24 of 1936 to attach the Continent of Africa to be the immovable property of the British Government has been repealed and is of no force, considered invalid.
10. The **Congress of SOUTH AFRICAN COMMUNITY GOVERNMENT UNION GENERAL GOVERNOR OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA** in pursue of paragraphs above to this press release is now empowered to issue the **NATIONAL LEGISLATIVE EXECUTIVE ORDERS** to ordain the principles of the Articles of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa Act 108 of 1996 which was adopted based on the **LONDON CONVENTION OF 27TH FEBRUARY 1884** now repealed.
11. **The Congress of SOUTH AFRICAN COMMUNITY GOVERNMENT UNION'S NATIONAL LEGISLATIVE EXECUTIVE ORDERS** now ordain the establishment of the **INSTITUTE OF FOREIGN GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY COMMITTEE** by a **STATE; BODY CORPORATE TRUST** between the **Congress of SOUTH AFRICAN COMMUNITY GOVERNMENT UNION, THE NATIONAL KINGS COUNCIL, THE AFRICAN UNION- AU, THE AFRICAN CENTRAL BANK, THE AFRICAN CENTRAL BANKS SYSTEM, THE UNITED STATES OF AFRICA'S CONSTITUTION** with **INSTITUTE OF FOREIGN GOVERNMENT AUTHORITY COMMITTEE** as a Trust to manage the **AFRICAN UNION** and the administration of all African **RULING POLITICAL PARTIES** of the current and future **AFRICAN UNION administrative Executive Order** reported by this press release.
12. That this National Legislative Executive Order is hereby ordained to deal with any incidental matter not specified by this press release mandate by **PUBLIC NOTICE GOVERNMENT GAZETTE OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA.**
